### **Accommodation and travel**

Below, you may find some useful information to organise your stay in Glasgow:

The closest and cheapest accommodation is the Premier Inn George Square, which is on George street about 100 meters from the conference venue. Booking now, on a non-refundable rate, the room comes at £35 per night (room only, pre-paid 'Premier Saver fee').<http://www.premierinn.com/en/checkHotel/GLACIT/glasgow-city-centre-george-square>.

Also close to the conference venue are the Brunswick Hotel (from £50 per room) <http://www.brunswickhotel.co.uk/> and the more upmarket the Millenium Hotel which is right on George square <http://www.millenniumhotels.co.uk/millenniumglasgow>.

Glasgow can be reached by **plane** travelling to:

- Glasgow International airport - c. 30 minutes from the city centre by bus (to Buchanan bus station, bus 500, every 10 minutes <http://www.glasgowairport.com/im-departing/getting-here> - Buchanan bus station is about 10 minutes on foot to the conference venue) or c. 15-20 minutes by taxi.
- Glasgow Prestwick airport - about 1 hour by train from Glasgow Central Station (check timetable here <http://scotrail.com/>)
- Edinburgh International airport - about 1 hour to Glasgow Buchanan bus station with direct bus, available every thirty minutes (<http://www.citylink.co.uk/journeyplanner.php>).

From within the UK you can of course travel by **train**. The closest main station is Glasgow Queen street (10 minutes on foot). Glasgow Central Station is also within walking distance from the conference venue (c. 20 minutes).
